Dear Parents / Carers,

On the 8th April, Riley Ketley, a pupil at Longcroft School sadly passed away after a tragic accident. A number of our students have been directly affected by this tragedy and the Wellbeing Team at Beverley High School have offered support to those students. If your child has been affected by this devastating incident and in need of further help, please encourage them to speak to their Head of Year or a member of the Wellbeing Team, alternatively, please contact Kim Mayfield.

Unfortunately, we have had a few reports from the police about anti-social behaviour from a group of young people who are gathering together on evenings and weekends near the flowers laid in memory of Riley. There are concerns about the use of alcohol and drugs. Further to this, these gatherings are in violation to the government's COVID rules. The police acknowledge that this incident is sensitive in nature and they appreciate that it is a difficult time for students. However, they have asked us to inform you that after the funeral on Thursday, the police will be giving out 'dispersal orders' to young people gathering in this area and anti- social behaviour may lead to a criminal record.

I apologise that I have to write this letter to share this warning; however, it is vital that we stick to government COVID guidelines and stop anti-social behaviour in order to keep our young people safe and to also help support the wellbeing of other individuals in our community.
